Start and Finish Point:

Edneys Bus Depot, Burchell Lane Mirboo North. (Next to Fire Station). Locked yard and large locked shed available for overnight storage of motor cycles. Toilet available. Area suitable for Vans, Caravans and Tents. (No showers available).

Saturday 17th April: (Approx. 80 kilometres)

Meet at Edneys Bus Depot at 10.30 am for an 11 am sharp start.

Run from Mirboo North to Yinnar, Driffield and onto Narracan for lunch. BBQ lunch Awty's at Oaklodge Narracan. Leisurely stay. Leave around 2.30 pm for Mirboo North via Thorpdale, Mirboo North.
